IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE:

- There are no ties allowed in playoffs! *Reference **GAME FORMAT** below if this occurs.*
- Please make sure all scores are recorded on the scoresheet before you leave.
- **For teams ranked 1-4:**
 - If you're uncertain about the validity of the other team's roster, please address this **before the game starts** between the EC and team captain. *Reference **ILLEGAL PLAYOFF ROSTER** below if this occurs.*
 - If you win the League Championship tonight, please submit your t-shirt order online. An email will be sent with more details on how to submit the order.

FACILITY DETAILS

- The closest sponsor bar is the **Canadian Brewhouse South**.
- We have the courts until **10:00 PM**.
- We will end match 1 at _____. *I will provide 5 minute and last rally warnings.*
- *Please ensure that all players have signed in at the front desk, and that you are off the courts by 10:00pm.*

GAME FORMAT

- *Matches are mandatory 3 games: rally point to 21, 21, and 15.*
- *Games must be won by 2 points but capped at 25, 25, and 17.*
- *A third game cannot be started if there is less than 5 minutes remaining in the match.*
- *Rock, Paper, Scissors for serve in the first and third games. The opposite team serves first in game 2.*
- Playoff Ties:
 - *If each team has won the same number of games, the team with the better point differential is the winner. If each team has an identical point differential, one additional point must be played to determine the winner.*

ILLEGAL PLAYOFF ROSTER

- *This only applies to players competing in a League Championship match (ranked 1-4). Follow these steps if anyone is concerned over the legitimacy of another player:*
 - *Ask the team captain if the player in question is listed on their roster (everybody playing must be listed on the roster and if ranked 1-4, must have played at least one match during the regular season):*
 - *If no – they are not allowed to play in the game (this was included in the playoff email sent by the Club and shouldn't be a surprise to them).*

****Please read ALL black announcements****

The green and red is information to assist you; they may not always be necessary to read out loud.

- *If yes – they are allowed to play but grab the full name of the person in question and include a quick summary of what happened in your score report. The office will then investigate further.*
- *Please mention that this is just protocol to ensure everybody is following the rules and guidelines and if they are saying everybody is legal, then there shouldn't be any worry about providing their teammates name. If the player in question ends up being illegal and wins the League Championship, the results of that game will be reviewed and there is a chance their win could be overturned. As such, this is the best opportunity to come clean!*

DEFAULTS

- *Ensure all teams have enough players to avoid defaults (1 total player with no gender requirement, is the minimum at start time). If this requirement isn't met, this team will automatically lose the first game 0-21 and then has 15 minutes to meet these requirements or they will lose the second game 0-21 and effectively the entire match. This process would repeat as soon as the second match starts. Fee is \$30/match. The Default Score includes the third game: 0-21; 0-21; 0-15.*

START GAMES

- *Announce who is playing who on which court (you decide). Repeat for Match 2.*
