## EVENT COORDINATOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

### Tuesday, June 23, 2026

#### IMPORTANT PLAYOFF REMINDERS:

- This is the **final week of regular season games** – playoffs are next week!
- For **Full Teams**:
  - All players must accept the roster invite from their captain to confirm their spot and be eligible to play.
  - Captains, make sure you have no outstanding roster invites.
- For **Individuals Teams**: No action is needed – your roster is already set.
- **Sub Rule**: Any subs playing in a top 4 playoff match must have played at least 1 regular season game. Contact ESSC with any questions about this rule.
- **Schedule**: Playoff matchups will be posted online by **Friday, June 26**.

#### REGISTRATION REMINDERS:

- Summer Registration Deadline has passed – check out the **Last-Minute League Availability** page on the website to see what is still open and accepting registrations...it's not too late to sign up!

#### FACILITY DETAILS

- The closest sponsor bar is **MKT Whyte Ave**.
- We will play **THREE** matches tonight.
- We have the courts until **8:30 PM**. Teams will have **40 minutes per match**.
- We will end match 1 at \_\_\_\_\_. *I will provide 5 minute & last rally warnings. Repeat for Match 2. Repeat for Match 3.*

#### DEFAULTS

- *Ensure all teams have enough players to avoid defaults (1 total player, no gender requirements, is the minimum at start time). If this requirement isn't met, this team will automatically lose the first game 0-11 and then has 15 minutes to meet these requirements or they will lose the second game 0-11 and effectively the entire match. This process would repeat as soon as the second/third match starts. Fee is \$30/match. The Default Score includes the third game: 0-11; 0-11; 0-11.*
- *If there is a male-male team in your co-ed league, please check in with the teams with the following options:*
  - a) *Play 1 vs. 2 and alternate the males between games.*
  - b) *Play 2 vs. 2 if they agree that the mercy win will automatically go to the opposing team.*
    - *These options should be presented to the teams but if the opposing team wants to play a legitimate 2 vs. 2 match and count the scores, they must indicate that before they play them and then cannot change their mind based on the results.*

#### START GAMES

- *Announce who is playing who on which court (you decide). Repeat for Match 2. Repeat for Match 3.*

#### GAME FORMAT
