IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE:

- A reminder that teams who make the Top 4, who would be playing for a shot at the championship, can only bring in subs who have played at least one regular season game with them. Please plan accordingly, should your team need subs for playoffs!

- **Please remember the following rules at the Pickleball Hub:**
 - *Do not enter the facility prior to 15 minutes ahead of scheduled start time.*
 - *Do not enter the gym space before the EC arrives.*
 - *Do not use any Pickleball Hub equipment.*
 - *Do not use any of the courts before scheduled start time.*

DEFAULTS

- *Ensure all teams have enough players to avoid defaults (1 total player, no gender requirements, is the minimum at start time). If this requirement isn't met, this team will automatically lose the first game 0-11 and then has 15 minutes to meet these requirements or they will lose the second game 0-11 and effectively the entire match. This process would repeat as soon as the second match starts. Fee is \$30/match. The Default Score includes the third game: 0-11; 0-11; 0-11.*
- *If there is a male-male team in your co-ed league, please check in with the teams with the following options:*
 - a) *Play 1 vs. 2 and alternate the males between games.*
 - b) *Play 2 vs. 2 if they agree that the mercy win will automatically go to the opposing team.*
 - *These options should be presented to the teams but if the opposing team wants to play a legitimate 2 vs. 2 match and count the scores, they must indicate that before they play them and then cannot change their mind based on the results.*

START GAMES

- *Announce who is playing who on which court. Repeat for Match 2.*

GAME FORMAT

- **Matches are mandatory 3 games: non-rally point to 11 for all games.**
- **Games must be won by 2 points but capped at 15.**
- **A third game cannot be started if there is less than 5 minutes remaining in the match.**
- **Rock, Paper, Scissors for serve in the first and third games. The opposite team serves first in game 2.**
