IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE:

- The ESSC hopes everyone had a great season!
- **For teams ranked 1-4:**
 - If you're uncertain about the validity of the other team's roster, please address this **before the game starts** between the EC and team captain. **Reference ILLEGAL PLAYOFF ROSTER below if this occurs.**
 - If you win the League Championship tonight, please submit your t-shirt order online. An email will be sent with more details on how to submit the order.
- At the end of each match, there will be a 5-minute warning. Only start a new game after these 5 minutes if your set score is currently tied.
 - At the conclusion of this final game, if the score is tied, a tie-break will be played. A tie-break is also used to break a 6-6 tie regardless of if the time has been called by the EC. **This means that you should let this tie-break game play on until it finishes to determine the winner. If it is not a League Champ game, encourage the players to wrap up quickly.**
 - **Reference TIE-BREAK on Page 2 if this occurs.**

ILLEGAL PLAYOFF ROSTER

- **This only applies to players competing in a League Championship match (ranked 1-4). Follow these steps if anyone is concerned over the legitimacy of another player:**
 - **Ask the team captain if the player in question is listed on their roster (everybody playing must be listed on the roster and if ranked 1-4, must have played at least one match during the regular season).**
 - **If no – they are not allowed to play in the game (this was included in the playoff email sent by the Club and shouldn't be a surprise to them).**
 - **If yes – they are allowed to play but grab the full name of the person in question and include a quick summary of what happened in your score report. The office will then investigate further.**
 - **Please mention that this is just protocol to ensure everybody is following the rules and guidelines and if they are saying everybody is legal, then there shouldn't be any worry about providing their teammates name. If the player in question ends up being illegal and wins the League Championship, the results of that game will be reviewed and there is a chance their win could be overturned. As such, this is the best opportunity to come clean!**

The green and red is information to assist you; they may not always be necessary to read out loud.

TIE-BREAK: Only reference the below information if a team reaches a tie-break.

- **Tie-break game: Serving Rotation**
 - Points are scored “Zero”, “1”, “2”, “3”, etc.
 - The first player to serve will start in the deuce court (right).
 - The following two points will be served by the opponents (the same player will serve both points) starting in the advantage court (left).
 - After this, each player/team shall serve alternately for two consecutive points (always starting in the advantage court) until the end of the tie-break game.
 - The rotation of service within each team shall continue in the same order as during that set.
 - The first team to reach 7 points with a 2 points margin is the winner of the tie-break and the set.
- **Deuce Court – Right**
- **Advantage Court – Left**
 - Point 1 – (Deuce) Player X Serves – whoever is next in line to serve from the original rotation.
 - Point 2 – (Advantage) Player A Serves
 - Point 3 – (Deuce) Player A Serves
 - Point 4 – (Advantage) Player Y Serves
 - Point 5 – (Deuce) Player Y Serves
 - Point 6 – (Advantage) Player B Serves
 - Point 7 – (Deuce) Player B Serves
 - Point 8 – (Advantage) Player X Serves
 - Point 9 – (Deuce) Player X Serves

DEFAULTS

- **Ensure all teams have enough players to avoid defaults (1 total player, either male or female is the minimum at start time). If this requirement isn't met, this team will automatically lose the first two games and then has 15 minutes to meet these requirements, or they will lose the next two games. If they do not show up at all, they will forfeit the entire match. This process would repeat as soon as the next match starts. Fee is \$30/match.**
- **If there is a male-male team in your co-ed league, please check in with the teams with the following options:**
 - a) **Play 1 vs. 2 and alternate the males between games.**
 - b) **Play 2 vs. 2 if they agree that the mercy win will automatically go to the opposing team.**
 - **These options should be presented to the teams but if the opposing team wants to play a legitimate 2 vs. 2 match and count the scores, they must indicate that before they play them and then cannot change their mind based on the results.**

START GAMES

- **Announce who is playing who on which court (you decide). Repeat for Match 2.**

GAME FORMAT

- **The time slot will include a 5-minute warm-up, two 40-minute matches, and 5-minute intermissions.**
- **All Tennis leagues use a rally-point scoring system.**
 - **Advantage rules will apply, meaning that a game must be won by two points.**
- **Each match consists of a single set.**
 - **The team to win the most games during the set will be declared the winner.**
 - **When time expires, the current game will be played out, and the score will stand.**
