IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE:

- This is a fun first league; make sure you are calling your own infractions and striving to exhibit the best sportsmanship possible! Hard smashing is discouraged and please respect the level of your opponents.
- Game Play Reminders:
 - Each player must serve in their respective court.
 - The server should always have at least two balls on hand to keep the flow of games.
 - The server should always announce the current set score before the start of each game and the game score before each point.
 - The receiving player should always make the in/out call and must do so loud and clear.
- Both teams should confirm that all scores are recorded correctly on the scoresheet throughout the night.

DEFAULTS

- *Ensure there are enough players to avoid defaults (1 player, no gender requirement, is the minimum at start time). If this requirement isn't met, this team will automatically lose the first two games and then has 15 minutes to meet these requirements, or they will lose the next two games. If they do not show up at all, they will forfeit the entire match. This process would repeat as soon as the 2nd/3rd match starts. Fee is \$10/match.*

START GAMES

- *Announce who is playing who on which court (you decide). Repeat for 2nd & 3rd match.*

GAME FORMAT

- *All Tennis leagues use a rally-point scoring system.*
 - *Advantage rules will apply, meaning that a game must be won by two points.*
- *Each match consists of a single set.*
 - *The team to win the most games during the set will be declared the winner.*
 - *When time expires, the current game will be played out, and the score will stand*

****Court Lights (if needed):**

- Lights require 15 to 20 minutes to warm up
