## **GAME PLAY**

- Games Coordinators (GCs) are present to help monitor the action
- A game is 60 minutes in length.
- Regular Season: Ties are allowed

**Equipment:** Everything you need will be provided by <u>Combat Archery Edmonton</u>. All you need to bring are your indoor shoes and a water bottle.

**Rules:** Rules will be provided at the field by the Archery Games staff. But here are a few to read over:

- The game starts with each team on the yellow line close to their back fence. All arrows are lined up on the green center line. On-the-game leaders command both teams to run towards the green center line and grab the arrows. Players can start shooting immediately.
- Players can go right up to the center line to shoot but cannot cross over the center line to shoot. Players can cross over the line to steal arrows from the opposing team but they must leave their bow on their own side while doing so. Players can be shot by the opposing team while stealing arrows.
- Any player hit on their body or their bow is eliminated from the game. An arrow that bounces off the floor, wall or obstacle and then hits a player does not count.
- If an arrow is caught, the player who shot that arrow is eliminated.
- The game continues until all the players on one team have been eliminated and the surviving team is declared the winner.
