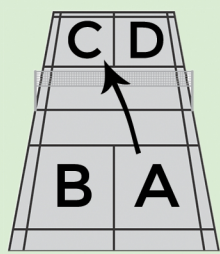


This is an example of a doubles Tennis match between teams A & B and C & D.

**Scenario:**

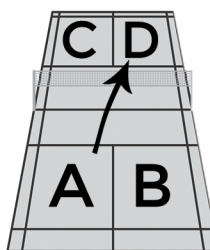
- A & B win the coin toss and choose to serve first.

Score: 0-0

Service: Serving from the **Right Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to C.

Winner: A & B



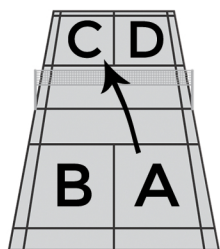
15-0

Service: Serving from the **Left Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to D.  
C & D do not move.

Winner: C & D



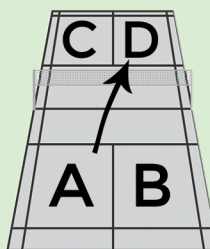
15-15

Score: 15-15

Service: Serving from the **Right Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to C.

Winner: A & B



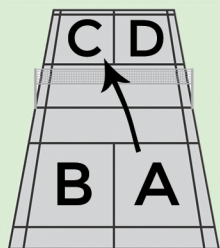
30-15

Score: 30-15

Service: Serving from the **Left Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to D.

Winner: C & D



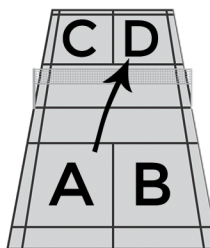
30-30

Score: 30-30

Service: Serving from the **Right Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to C.

Winner: C & D



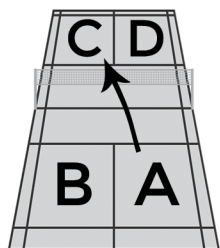
40-30

Score: 40-30

Service: Serving from the **Left Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to D.

Winner: A & B



40-40

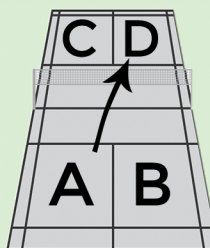
Deuce

Score: 40-40 = Deuce

Service: Serving from the **Right Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to C.

Winner: A & B



Advantage  
A & B

Score: Advantage A & B

Service: Serving from the **Left Service Court.**

Server & Receiver: A serves to D.

Game Winner: A & B

The server will switch service courts every point, regardless of which team won the previous rally.
